COVID Clinical Response Committee (CCRC) Proposal

November 19, 2020

CCRC Purpose:

Small group committee to provide rapid clinical decision making around the management of COVID-19 for William Osler Health System (Osler) during Ontario's second wave of COVID-19. The committee is being launched at the request of senior clinical leadership through the Clinical Services Leadership Team (CSLT).

CCRC Scope:

Primarily dedicated to medical management of COVID-19 and Osler's response to COVID-19 including maintenance of COVIDcriticalcare.ca website. Scope may be broadened at the request of CSLT or SLT.

CCRC Goals:

1. Review and update the website covidcriticalcare.ca to ensure all areas are up to date with current provincial guidelines, hospital policy and best practice. This is expected to be completed within 3 weeks of the committee's inception. Upon completion the work will be presented at CSLT.
2. Respond to specific Osler organizational questions regarding management of COVID-19 with a formal response produced within 5-7 days with a presentation to CSLT or SLT.
